

Discharge Pathway for Patients with Malignant Melanoma January 2021

Discharge of patient from the cancer centre is subject to availability of established primary care provider.

Patients on clinical trials will continued to follow up within the cancer centre if required.

Discharge guidelines need to be discussed in detail with patient and families.

All non-metastatic metastatic melanoma patients need to be referred to a dermatologist.

All patients should be provided information on self-examination of skin

Stage 1A: Patient can be discharged after initial evaluation.

Stage 1b to II: Patient can be discharged after three year of follow up at cancer centre.

Stage III: Patient can be discharged after five years of follow up at the cancer centre.
