You have now completed your chemotherapy at the cancer centre prior to surgery for your bladder cancer.

Your urologist, Dr. \_\_\_\_\_\_ will now schedule your surgery (radical cystectomy).

Your urologist will continue to provide your care as they see fit, and then your care will then be transferred to your family physician/nurse practitioner. Information about your care will be sent to your family physician/nurse practitioner.

Your urologist may decide to refer you back to the cancer centre if they feel you need additional treatment.

We encourage you to have a healthy lifestyle, which includes a healthy diet, exercise and avoiding smoking or excessive alcohol consumption.
