



Discharge Pathway Non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma

Discharge pathway for patient completing treatment for high grade non-Hodgkin's lymphoma:

- Discharge of patient from cancer centre is subject to availability of established primary care provider (family physician or nurse practitioner).
- Patients of clinical trials will continued to follow up within cancer centre if required.
- Discharge guidelines need to be discussed in detail with patient and families and need to be adequately explained to the primary care provider.

Patients care can be transferred to family physician or nurse practitioner if patient remains free of disease and have:

- Completed recommend 2 to 3 years of follow up at cancer centre.
- Completed recommended 5 years of follow up at cancer centre after high dose chemotherapy and autologous stem cell transplant.

Patients who received an allogenic stem cell transplant as part of Lymphoma treatment will continued to be followed by stem cell transplant team for life.
